Newtone Drycleaners celebrates 70 years!

This year Newtone Drycleaners celebrates 70 years.

In the peak there were nearly 50 staff to operate the five factories between Dunedin, Gore and Oamaru. There were up to 14 shops, dozens of agents, multiple household van runs and serviced nearly all the hotels and motels in Dunedin.

Interesting they processed all the industrial cleaning for NZTS (Dunedin) Ltd.

They certainly saw a lot of changes over the years seeing the machinery evolve from white spirits to Perc. One of the very first dry cleaning companies in NZ to have a perc machine

Wet garments coming out of machines into extractors and then into a dryer to fully enclosed machines.

Percy (an Accountant) Marks Father, was heavily involved in researching the latest trends and was a frequent speaker at international trade shows and involved in the start up of the TCF, including helping establish the original constitution.

One of ideas brought back was a partnership with Sanitone for the detergents which latest for many years.

Website Updates

BL Stringer has highlighted the current global shortage of semi-conductors and the impact this is having and will continue to have on the availability of chips.

Having recently partnered with **Bundle** to become one of their Premium Textile Providers gives BL Stringer access to Data Mars chips for 5Oc per piece. Bundle find themselves in the unique position of having access to secure LaundryChip supplies having pre-purchased large quantities so are likely to be one of the few suppliers unaffected by the shortage while others may struggle with supply over the coming months as stock run out.
